



Cross Creek FFA Chapter Chapter Officer Team Format

Purpose:

To provide a format for the Cross Creek FFA Chapter Officer team which will be designed to give more students leadership opportunities and responsibilities above the general membership level and to better prepare students for leadership roles at the local, area, state, and national levels.

Implementation:

All officer candidates will go through an interview screening. Candidates will be given a specific interview date and time. If a candidate is absent or late to the interview, his/her application will be void. Senior officers will conduct ALL interviews and will select the next year's officer team. The newly elected Cross Creek FFA officers will be announced at the end of the FFA Awards Banquet.

Selection of Cross Creek FFA Chapter Officer

1. Applications must be received by the CC FFA advisor no later than **March 15 by 3:00 pm.** The Cross Creek application is enclosed.
2. Senior chapter officers will be conducting interviews of potential officers.
3. The following officer positions will be selected:
President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Sentinel, Chaplain, Historian, and/or Student Advisor
4. The newly elected Cross Creek FFA officer team will officially begin their terms the moment they are announced at the FFA Awards Banquet. Newly elected officers will assist the current officers during the closing ceremony at the chapter awards banquet.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must not be heavily involved in other clubs, organizations, or sports.**
2. Must agree to attend **ALL** required events.
3. Must have taken at least one agricultural course and been an FFA member for one year.
4. Must be an active member in good standing with the National FFA Organization and local chapter.
5. Must serve while attending high school.

Responsibilities:

1. Assist the advisor and officers in planning and implementation in all chapter activities.
2. Assist in development and execution of the chapter FFA banquet.
3. Assist in the funding of activities that is planned throughout the year.
4. Must agree to plan and fill out chapter program activities at the chapter officer leadership training.
5. Must agree to and maintain the standards of the Official FFA dress sent forth by the National FFA Organization.
- 6. Maintain "C" average in all classes.**
7. Must attend ALL chapter meetings and ALL assigned committee meetings.
- 8. Cell phones/tardiness will NOT BE tolerated at any chapter/officer meeting.**
9. Must maintain their chapter officer notebook and keep a log of working hours.
10. Purchase an official jacket and tie/scarf as well as an officer shirt.

Required Events

Required events will be provided on the Officer Agreement form that will be signed by all newly elected officers and their parents/guardians.
