### **What is FFA Summer Leadership Camp?**

Summer Leadership Camp is a Monday thru Friday camp for FFA members from across the state of Georgia. The purpose of camp is to create a positive learning experience in building leadership and teambuilding skills. Summer Leadership Camp is the highlight of every FFA member's summer. Activities include softball and volleyball competitions, dances, a mud course, assemblies, talent shows, free recreation, leadership training, and much more! Summer camp engages all students with a common core which is... FFA! Summer camp is held at the Georgia FFA/FFCLA Center in Covington. Food and lodging are included in the registration fee, as well as a camp shirt. The memories and friendships that your child will make during Summer Leadership Camp will be priceless. The Georgia FFA/FCCLA Center will be offering six weeks of Summer Leadership Camp. The Cross Creek FFA is aiming to attend camp during the week of **June 10-14, 2019**. Registration for this specific week will depend on an online process managed by the Georgia FFA/FCCLA center. If this week reaches the maximum number of attendees before Cross Creek FFA can be accepted, an alternate week will be taken into consideration. If an alternate week is not available refunds will be given.

The total price of camp will be **\$200.00**.

To secure a position, a **\$100.00 non-refundable deposit** (included in the total price) is due to Mrs. Henderson no later than **February 20, 2019**. (If paying with a check please make it payable to Cross Creek FFA).

**A second deposit of \$50.00 will be due on April 18, 2019 with a final deposit of \$50.00 being due on May 15, 2019.**

On May 15, 2019, a parent meeting will be held at the school in room 108 to sign all required field trip forms for the RCSS and the Georgia FFA/FCCLA Center.

Please read and sign the attached Parental Consent Form and return it along with the **\$100.00 non-refundable registration fee by February 20, 2019**. The total payment of \$200.00 will be accepted upfront but is not necessary.

*NOTE: If your child will be unable to attend camp due to unforeseen circumstances all monies will be refunded EXCEPT the \$100.00 non-refundable deposit. Mrs. Henderson, along with Cross Creek's administration, will make the final decision on the students that will be allowed to attend Summer Leadership Camp based on discipline, attendance, and academic records no matter if registration was paid in full.*
